

Touched by the Wilderness – 8 Day



Days 1 to 3 - Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary

Drive from Johannesburg or Nelspruit to the Oshoek Border Post and enter Swaziland and stop at the Ngwenya Glass factory. Travel the short distance to Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary. Mlilwane is Swaziland's oldest protected area and gave birth to the concept of nature conservation in the Kingdom. Enjoy the unique opportunity to walk amongst zebra and antelope or discover blue duiker outside your room.

Accommodation: Reilly's Rock is steeped in history and features an up-market lodge. This tranquil setting is on top of a large rocky outcrop and has stunning views over the surrounding area and you can sit and watch the plethora of birdlife as well as wander through the botanical gardens.

Days 4 to 5 - Foresters Arms Hotel

The Foresters Arms dates from colonial times and is a place of great character and charm. It is gloriously situated on its own estate in the mountains and set in the heart of the Kingdom it is ideal for exploring all attractions.

Accommodation: The bedrooms are tastefully decorated, with bathrooms en suite, telephones and satellite TV. The personal touch of the Foresters Arms spills over into the bedrooms as well where they have a homely and welcoming feeling to them.

Days 6 to 7 - Phophonyane Nature Reserve

Phophonyane Falls Ecolodge is nestled in the dramatic mountain landscape of north-west Swaziland, amid tumbling waterfalls and lush natural forests. It is a favourite destination for discerning travellers and nature lovers.

Accommodation: The stylishly ethnic beehives are luxurious and romantic versions of Swazi traditional accommodation complete with windows and en suite bathrooms, done with natural materials and original artwork and ceramics.

Day 8 – depart

Travel to the Jeppe's Reef border and back into South Africa
