

Passing through Swaziland – 4 Day



Days 1 - Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary

Drive from Johannesburg or Nelspruit to the Oshoek Border Post, enter Swaziland and stop at the Ngwenya Glass factory. Travel the short distance to Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary. Mlilwane is Swaziland's oldest protected area and gave birth to the concept of nature conservation in the Kingdom. Enjoy the unique opportunity to walk amongst zebra and antelope or discover blue duiker outside your room.

Accommodation: Reilly's Rock is steeped in history and features an up-market lodge. This tranquil setting is on top of a large rocky outcrop and has stunning views over the surrounding area and you can sit and watch the plethora of birdlife as well as wander through the botanical gardens.

Days 2 - Foresters Arms Hotel

The Foresters Arms dates from colonial times and is a place of great character and charm. It is gloriously situated on its own estate in the mountains and set in the heart of the Kingdom it is ideal for exploring all attractions.

Accommodation: The bedrooms are tastefully decorated, with bathrooms en suite, telephones and satellite TV. The personal touch of the Foresters Arms spills over into the bedrooms as well where they have a homely and welcoming feeling to them.

Days 3 - Mkhaya

Depart Foresters Arms and make time for a visit to the Swazi Candle Studio. Arrive at Mkhaya in the early afternoon. Mkhaya; A premier reserve which has the elusive black rhino. Unique and intimate encounters with Mkhaya's wildlife are exceptional and all travel within the reserve is by open Land Rovers or on foot.

Accommodation: beautiful cottages situated in the bush which are laid out discretely in the riverine forest overlooking the dry riverbed. Luxury in the bush.

Day 4 – depart

Travel to the Golela into KwaZuluNatal or Lomahasha border into Mozambique
